

Quick Tips for Generating NOMS Data Report

Log In Instructions:

- Go to the NOMS homepage at <http://www.asha.org/NOMS/> and click on the link to the **NOMS Data Collection and Reporting Tool** on the left navigation bar or go directly to [NOMS Data Collection and Reporting Tool](#). Remember to bookmark the new site.
- After you log in with your username and password, you will be directed to the NOMS Landing Page to “ENTER DATA” or “VIEW DATA REPORTS”.
- Click on “VIEW DATA REPORTS” to begin.

Generating a Data Report:

- To generate a data report, you must enter in all of the required criteria (*).
- Important Note:** *The screen shots throughout this guide reflect the criteria and data items collected for the Adult component. The Pre-Kindergarten application, report criteria, and data items will differ from the Adult component however the process to generate a report is the same.*
- Select the NOMS component and the facility or group of facilities you wish to generate a report for. Only the facility/facilities you are linked to will be listed in the drop down box.
 - Use the “Check all” feature if you wish to combine the data from all of the facilities in which you work or select a specific facility or group of facilities from the drop down menu. You may also search for a particular facility by typing in the name or state using the “Filter” option.

- Select the time period for which you want to receive a report.

Important Note: Reports are based on date of submission. That is, only patient records that were submitted into the NOMS system during the selected time period will be included in your report.

- The report date automatically defaults to one year. Use the calendar to modify the time period or type in the specific dates for your report using the MM/DD/YY format.

- Select the treatment setting or settings and the medical diagnosis/es from the drop down menu or use the “Check all” feature to generate a report which includes all settings and/or diagnoses.

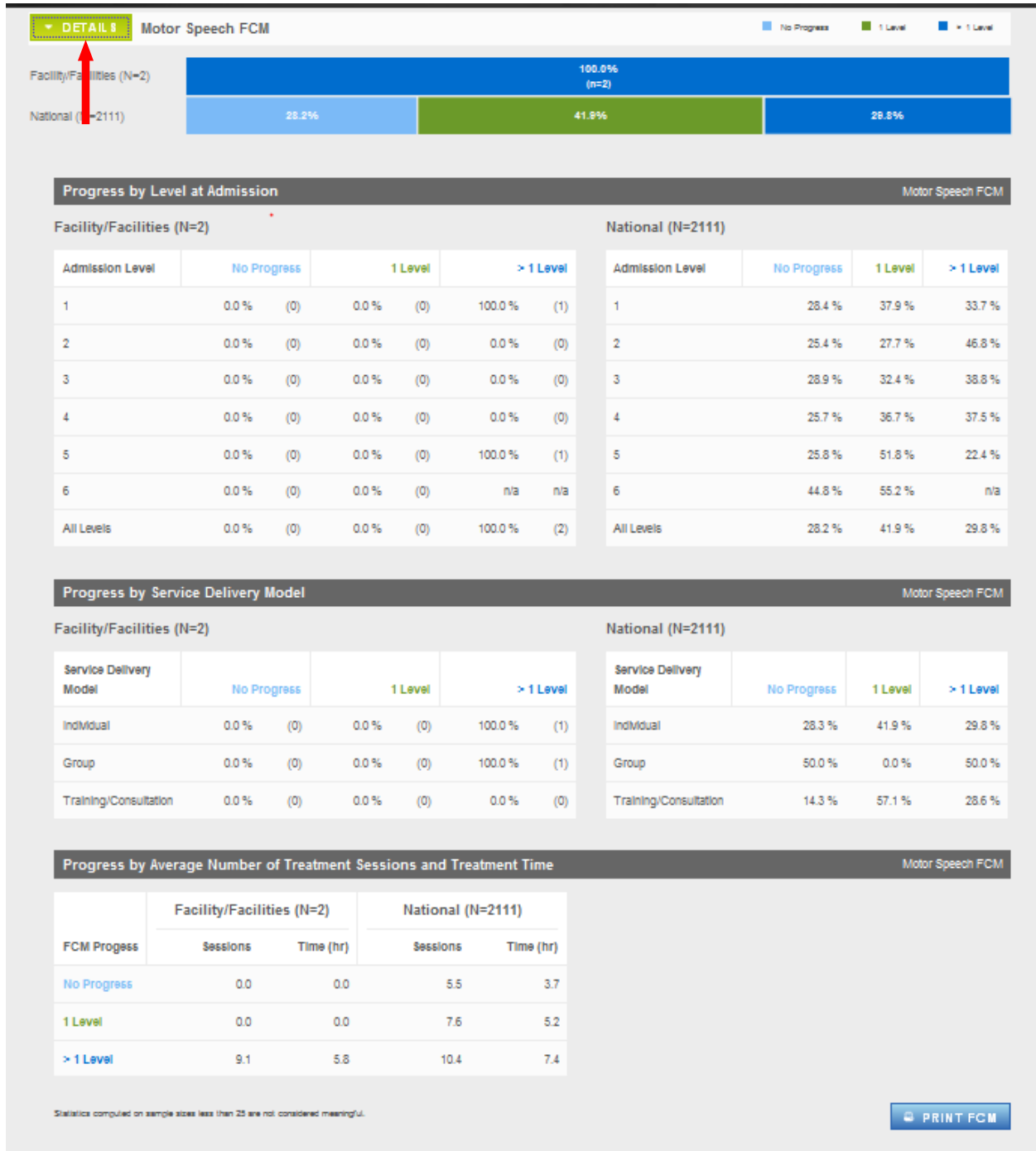

Displaying Data Reports:

- The top half of your data report will display the progress in the top 5 FCMs treated in your facility or group of facilities compared to the national data. Use the drop down menu to view data on additional FCMs.
- Click on the “DETAILS” icon to view more detailed information about a specific FCM.



- Under the “DETAILS” section, you will receive your organization’s data compared to the national data in the following areas:
 - Progress in FCM by admission levels
 - Progress in FCM by service delivery model
 - Progress in FCM by average number of treatment sessions
 - Progress in FCM by hours of treatment provided



- The bottom half of your data report will display specific demographic and treatment information about the patients receiving speech and language treatment in your facility or group of facilities. The data will reflect the most frequent response for each category in your facility or group of facilities.
- Click on the “DETAILS” icon to view more detailed information about your patients compared to similar patients treated nationally.

- Click on the “LOGOUT” icon to exit the NOMS system.
